### Your itinerary

As soon as you arrive in Stuttgart, you will be welcomed, with a tour of the factory, where you will see how a Porsche is assembled. This is followed by a visit to the Porsche Museum – where you will learn the whole captivating history of the company – and lunch at the Christophorus Restaurant.

A little later, it's time to take to the wheel yourself – and explore the driving dynamics of your Porsche. On your first

drive you will encounter different types of road. And your destination, surrounded by vineyards: the Schloss Steinburg Hotel, sitting in splendour overlooking the city of Würzburg. A stylish accommodation for your first night.

After breakfast, you set off for Leipzig. What can you expect? Winding roads through the Thuringian Forest to Eisenach. 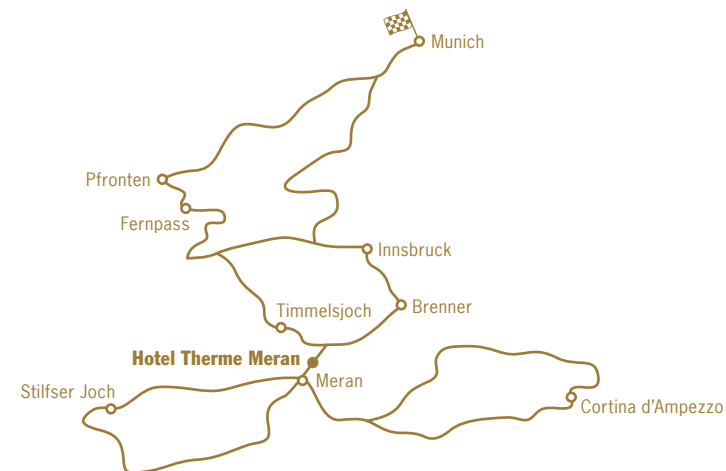

Back in the driver's seat again, the next day takes you over the Ofenpass and along exciting serpentine bends towards Meran. Stop for lunch at the Castel Fragsburg restaurant, before continuing through the Ötz Valley and along the Timmelsjoch to Telfs. The impressive rocky crags of the Dolomites are a striking symbol of South Tyrol. Enjoy sights such as Brixen, Meran and Bozen, and put your driving skills to the test on spectacular mountain passes and numerous twists and turns well above sea level.

### Your itinerary

Your tour starts in Munich, where you collect your Porsche. You will be able to put it straight to the test, exploring its driving dynamics and spectacular acceleration on the first leg of your journey to South Tyrol. Break for lunch, 1,130 metres up, at the Schlossanger Alp restaurant in Pfronten, before continuing on your way through the Fernpass, a part of the tour that you'll remember for its magnificent lakes. Let your eyes wander for just a moment, before tackling the Timmelsjoch, and the challenging bends that will take you to Meran and the Passeier Valley.

In the Passeier Valley you will find the first-class Hotel Therme Meran, your base for the next few days' driving – providing you with a touch of comfort during your stay, for example a 1,150 m<sup>2</sup> wellness centre including indoor and outdoor pools and a sauna area. In addition to offering outstanding comfort and service, it features an exciting design concept by star designer Matteo Thun. In the evening you will be enchanted – by the excellent cuisine, and also by the next day's route we present.

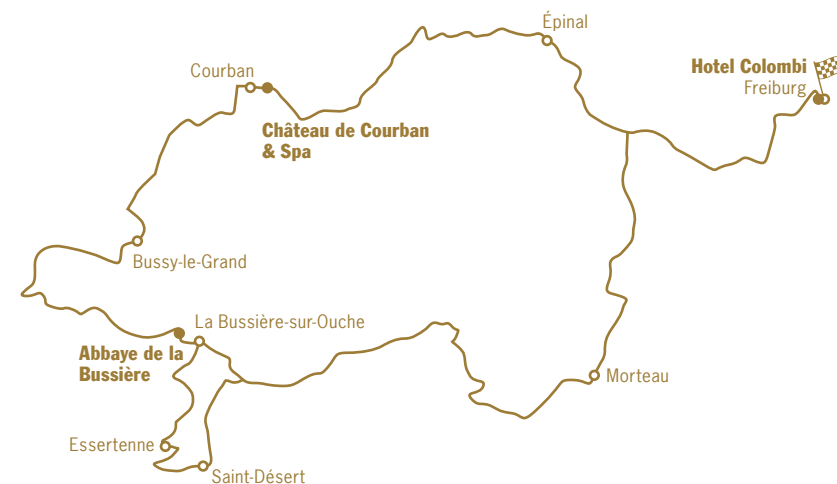
Back in the driver's seat, the next day's route takes you from Meran to Cortina d'Ampezzo, a town set at an altitude of 1,211 metres in the heart of the Dolomites. It's famous for its excellent alpine infrastructure and countless curves on the journey there. An exciting prospect, especially for Porsche enthusiasts. Round off an eventful day in style, with a superb dinner at the Castel Fragsburg.

Your first destination on the following day: an exhilarating drive. Provided by the twists and turns of the Stilfser Joch. The second-highest paved mountain pass in the Alps, it is a truly unforgettable experience. Then it's time for lunch in a stylish restaurant. Fully refreshed, and with that unmistakable dynamic Porsche performance, you set off again for Meran, which rests in a basin, surrounded by mountains, where the Passeier Valley, Etschtal and Vinschgau meet. An ideal place to unwind. In the soothing thermal baths for instance, which you can access directly from the hotel. Dinner is a fitting conclusion to your tour, served in the picturesque surroundings right in the heart of Meran's old quarter.

The day of your return journey dawns. But it does bring something good: you will be driving back in a Porsche. Along the magnificent backdrop of the Jaufenpass and Brenner. And, even if it only partially alleviates the pain of separation, there's a wealth of culinary delights and regional specialities to enjoy at the Schloss Elmau near Krün, before your tour comes to a close in Munich.

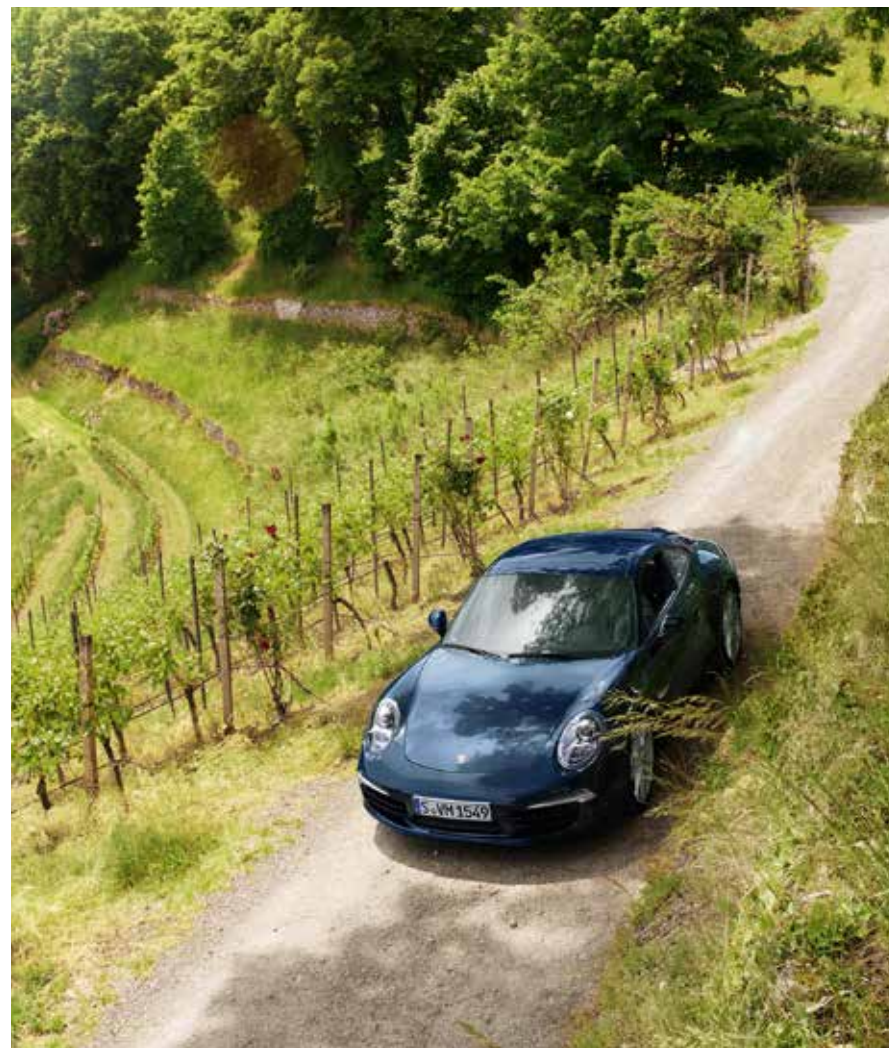
## Porsche Tour of Burgundy

**Mountains, castles, vineyards? Sounds good. And even better with the sound of Porsche.**



### 5 days

- 4 nights' accommodation, 4 days' driving
- Winding roads through the spectacular scenery of this world-famous wine region
- Savour the regional specialities of the Burgundy region
- Visit the Château de Bussy-Rabutin and Château de Pommard
- Plenty of time at the wheel



**Burgundy: a region full of cultural and culinary appeal. Your tour takes you to vineyards, mountains, castles and the best local cuisine, in a legendary sports car – your own Porsche. With so many impressions to take in, of course, there should also be lots of relaxation: after your days on the road, you spend the night in grand style.**

### Your itinerary

Your tour starts and finishes in Freiburg, in sunny Breisgau – the Hotel Colombi to be precise. Once you have checked in, we welcome you with an aperitif and set the atmosphere for the next few days. Dinner that evening is in the hotel restaurant. The next morning, you collect your Porsche and set off for Épinal and the very first highlight en route: lunch at the Les Ducs de Lorraine restaurant (one Michelin star). Culinary delights are followed by motoring pleasure, as your exhilarating journey continues along the meandering roads to the idyllic village of Courban in the world-famous Burgundy wine region. Your final destination for the day is the Château de Courban & Spa. This traditional-style,

owner-managed hotel offers a wealth of charming features and excellent cuisine.

On day two, you take to the driver's seat once more for the drive from Courban to Flavigny-sur-Ozerain, stopping off along the way at the Château de Bussy-Rabutin. Built in the Renaissance style, the castle has been a listed building since 1862 and is a true delight for anyone interested in culture.

Break for lunch at the Ferme Auberge La Grange restaurant and take the opportunity to review the experiences of the morning. Then, take to the wheel again to drive through the magnificent Burgundy countryside to La Bussière-sur-Ouche where you will spend the night at the Abbaye de la Bussière Hotel. This former Cistercian Abbey, dating from the 12th century, is set in parkland, surrounded by a lake and botanical gardens. In the evening, relax over dinner in the impressive cathedral-like setting of the hotel restaurant.

The next day is once again dedicated to pure driving pleasure. En route, stop off in Beaune. The first cultural highlight here is a guided tour of the Château de Pommard.

Attractions include the stone wine cellars in whose vaults the famous Pinot noir is bottled. Then, the next highlight is already waiting for you: a visit to the famous Beaune market on Place de la Halle. Take lunch in the restaurant Le Carmin where you are expected by head chef Christophe Quéant, whose cuisine has already been awarded a Michelin star. Afterwards, set off back to the Abbaye de la Bussière Hotel. In the evening, you are invited to a farewell dinner at the Sainte-Sabine vineyard estate – including a wine tasting featuring some of the finest vintages from the Burgundy region.

On the final day of your tour, you head for Villers-le-Lac. Stop off for a leisurely gourmet lunch at the Le France restaurant, before enjoying the final part of your journey back to Freiburg in your Porsche.

Having gained a wealth of city impressions in Vienna, the next day is all about exploring the performance of your Porsche. Set off on the drive through

After checking into your room at the elegant Hotel Heinitzburg, the rest of the afternoon is free to spend as you please. At dinner in the hotel restaurant, savour international specialities and seductive South African wines.
