1 - General

1.1 Organization

The Organizing Committee of the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program 2019 is composed of Porsche France, Oreca and Michelin.

1.2 Guarantees

Application of the general requirements of the F.F.S.A Risks C and D is mandatory.

Additional insurance for participants is highly recommended by the organizer.

In the event of any claim whatsoever while driving one of the cars used during the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program event, the driver accepts to cover all of the financial consequences of any damages caused to the car which he/she is using, within the limit of 10,000€ (ten thousand euros) and undertakes to pay this sum to the organizer without delay.

2- Calendar Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program 2019

The Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program will take place from Sunday the 20th of October 2019 – 5:00 pm to Tuesday the 22nd of October 2019 – 18:00 pm.

As part of the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program, participants will be accommodated at the Grand Prix Hôtel*** at Le Castellet.

The Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program will take place at the Circuit Paul Ricard and its surroundings.

3 – Sports Regulations

3.1 Drivers

The Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program 2019 is open to all drivers who have participated in 3 or fewer Porsche Carrera Cup or GT3 Cup Challenge meetings and who were born between 30.11.1994 and 01.03.2004. In addition, to participate, drivers must hold a national or international license F.F.S.A or a license issued by another A.S.N (National Sports Association) affiliated to the International Automobile Federation (FIA). Registration fees must be paid to participate in the selection tests.

3.2 Registration and applications

To be eligible to participate in the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program 2019, the driver must send his registration form before October 15th, 2019 using the registration request issued by the organizer. The duly completed and signed application form must be sent to the following address:

4 – Sequence of the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program

4.1 Event

During the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program, drivers will be coached by the Porsche Carrera Cup France Team and Patrick Pilet (Official Porsche Motorsport Driver). Throughout their stay, the drivers will discover the Porsche brand and its values, while benefiting from personalized management.

4.2 Selection

The selections will take place on October 21st, 2019 on the school track of the circuit Paul Ricard (1,8km), with a Porsche 911 GT3 Cup and with a Porsche of series.

The sport tests and individual interviews will take place on October 22nd, 2019.

4.3 Winning Driver of the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program 2019

The winner of the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program 2019, whom has been selected by the Organizing Committee based on sporting and extra-sporting criteria (after evaluation), will receive a purse of 40,000€ ex VAT to participate in the Porsche Carrera Cup France 2020.

He/she will also receive, from Michelin, an allocation of a set of four tyres to be used in the 2020 season.

In addition, he/she will receive financial support from a Porsche Partner Center for a minimum amount of 10,000€ ex VAT.

Finally, the winner will be declared the «Hope of the Porsche Carrera Cup France 2020»; his/her appointment will be announced on or before November 29, 2019.

4.4 Special Provisions

Participation in the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program 2019 will result in the sale of all copyrights and image rights of teams and drivers to Porsche France. This includes all the images, videos and sound bites from the Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program 2019 which are taken for TV, press, DVD and Internet broadcast purposes worldwide.

5 – Winning driver of the Porsche Carrera Cup France – Junior Program 2019

5.1 Payment of bonuses and endowments

Prizes will be paid to the competitor listed on the 2019 Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program registration form.

If necessary, and upon written request, the bonuses and endowments may be paid directly to the team which will be responsible for running the « Hope of the Porsche Carrera Cup France 2020 ».

5.2 Porsche Carrera Cup France - Season 2019

The winning driver must use the 2019 Porsche Carrera Cup France Junior Program purse to participate in the Porsche Carrera Cup France 2020 with the team of his/her choice in a 911 GT3 Cup Type 991. The driver will also have personalized coaching and communication support during all the season.
