

Bulletin 3/2020

Supplement to the Regulations DMSB Visa no. 610/20, of
24.02.2020.

The amendment is valid with immediate effect.

(Changes/Additions are printed in **bold italic**)

Part 1: Sporting Regulations

4.1 Entries is changed/supplemented as follows:

" ...

- (b) Each individual application by a competitor must be for a minimum of 2 and maximum of 3 cars. If a team wishes to permanently enter additional cars, they must be entered under a separate competitor's licence. Exceptions from this regulation are Guest entries for a fourth car which may be submitted under one competitor licence. The competitor will receive a written confirmation if his entry has been accepted. ***The Series Organiser recognises the difficulties posed by the current Covid-19 pandemic and, as a consequence, is prepared to consider (on an exceptional basis) applications from competitors for withdrawal of one car from the permanent entry provided that three cars have been entered under one licence. Where a competitor has entered a total of more than three cars under multiple licences, applications will be considered for withdrawal of one car per three cars entered. If the withdrawal of a car results in the minimum of two cars for a particular competitor licence not being reached, the remaining car(s) of that competitor must be reassigned as necessary between licences to ensure that the minimum/maximum number of cars per remaining licence is respected. The competitor must inform the Series Organiser in writing of any such reassignment of the car(s).***

4.2 Entry fees for the season and per competition is changed as follows:

"The entry fee for the first two cars is:

For entries received up to and including 15.Dec.2019 EUR 25,180 plus VAT*

For entries received after 15.Dec.2019 EUR 27,580 plus VAT*

*** Prices do not include the value added tax as effective by law, if applicable.**

The entry fee for the first two cars includes the following services:

- **Participation fee for two race cars in all Series competitions**
- **Eight 3-day team catering tickets per event**
- **Eight Support Event Paddock passes per event**
- **Six parking passes for the support event car park per event**
- **Participation fee for two cars at the official season test**
- **Provision of basic hygiene and personal protection equipment (e.g. masks, gloves, disinfectants)**
- **Onsite PCR tests at race events where mandatory**

The entry fee for each further car irrespective if entered as a third car under the competitor licence of the first two cars or entered as a fourth, fifth or sixth car under a second or third competitor licence when submitting the "Application for Team Entry" is:

For entries received up to and including 15.Dec.2019 EUR 8,980 plus VAT*

For entries received after 15.Dec.2019 EUR 10,300 plus VAT*

*** Prices do not include the value added tax as effective by law, if applicable.**

The entry fee for each further car includes the following services:

- **Participation fee for one race car in all Series competitions**
- **Four 3-day team catering tickets per event**
- **Four Support Event Paddock passes per event**
- **Three parking passes for the support event car park per event**
- **Participation fee for one car at the official season test**
- **Provision of basic hygiene and personal protection equipment (e.g. masks, gloves, disinfectants)**
- **Onsite PCR tests at race events where mandatory**

The Series Organiser will issue an invoice including VAT where applicable. An invoice will be issued after the Series Organiser has assessed the individual "Application for Team Entry". The invoice is not a confirmation of the "Application for Team Entry" or of entry to the Series.

Once the "Application for Team Entry" has been accepted and confirmed in writing by the Series Organiser and the entry fee has been paid in full and in due time the entry is valid, and the competitor is entitled and obliged to participate.

Any overpayments already made will be refunded to the Competitor by the Series Organiser."
